Gröt or porridges were a staple of the Viking diet and probably eaten on a daily basis. There are countless combinations and regional variations of both sweet and savory gröts. This is a healthy Viking Age dessert option. Made with ingredients available in the winter. Sweet and tart flavors that make a good addition to your holiday table. The cherries of the time were sweet cherries. Super simple to make and also is fantastic for breakfast.

2c dry sweet cherries
2 qt black cherry juice or whey from making skyr. (I like a 1 to 1 ratio if possible)
2c pearl barley (can sub steel cut oats for gluten free option)
Pinch of salt
4T butter
1c crushed hazelnuts
2c plain skyr (can sub Greek yogurt or chevre)
Honey to drizzle

Add the cherry juice and dried cherries to a pot. Bring to a boil over medium heat (important so the cherries have time to plump).

Add pinch of salt, butter, and barley/oats. Stir until it returns to a boil.

Put on a lid, reduce heat to low, put a lid on it, do other things for 45 mins.


After the 45 minutes, give it a stir. Serve topped with skyr, hazelnuts, and a drizzle of honey. Serves 8 for breakfast, 16 as a side dish.


SCA Heraldry – Tinctures

Within SCA Heraldry we have primarily 7 tinctures (excluding furs) that are permissible. These are the two metals argent (which is white or silver), Or (which is yellow or gold and when blazoned is capitalized), and the 5 colors sable (black), vert (green), gules (red), purpura (purple) and azure (blue).



SENA requires that charges have suitable contrast between themselves and the fields or ordinary that they are placed on. For contrast a metal must be placed on a color and a color must be placed on a metal, with either being able to be placed onto a neutral field that does not use the tincture of the charge.



Some examples would be: Argent, a lion rampant sable (color on metal). Sable a moon in her plenitude argent (metal on color). Per fess argent and sable a sun in its splendor overall Or (metal on neutral)
