Learn about the newest Baronial Award!

At Ursulmas, Your Excellencies announced the creation of a new Baronial Award, and bestowed it upon His Excellency Gideon Hravensfuri.

Can you tell us about the award in particular?

Zahra: The Shield of St. Ursul is an award meant to honor those who have significantly contributed, and by their very presence, improved the marshaling community in Aquaterra.

What was the gap in recognition you were aiming to fill?

Geirleikr: When we stepped into the role of Coronets of Aquaterra, one of the first things we looked at was the Awards. I felt there was an opportunity to introduce something to show appreciation to those who've contributed to the various martial aspects of our community over a longer term in a way that I felt was lacking. Not only contributing to the various fields of martial competition, but in the fostering and sharing of knowledge with others.

How did you decide on the name of the award?

G: Having studied various martial arts throughout my life, one thing has remained consistent. Martial prowess is for defense of yourself and those important to you. How could I address this in a name? Well, I primarily use a shield for defense. So, to me, that is a symbol easily recognized for protection.

Z: Additionally, we wanted to honor Aquaterra's history and so we pulled from The Legend of Saint Ursul by Dianna of the Silver Shore. Saint Ursul himself wielded a sword and shield in defense of his lady and land. So naming the award The Shield of Saint Ursul seemed appropriate.

What are the

criteria you consider for a recipient?

G: Long term contributions to the martial activities of the Barony, be they Armored, Rapier, Archery, or Thrown Weapons. We are looking for significant contributions both on the field of competition and in the instruction and guidance of others thereby strengthening the community overall.

Is this an award that you consider populace recommendations for, and if so, what would you like the populace to consider when recommending someone?

G: I would absolutely love to have recommendations for this to continue, not only through our time, but on into the future. I believe that only through the sharing of our knowledge can we continue to grow. I also recognize that as a primarily armored fighter, I don't have the visibility into the other disciplines to truly recognize those deserving thanks.

Z: We'd ask those recommending fellow populace members to consider the impact the person has had on the martial community and the length of time – looking for marathoners, not sprinters. Again, the person doesn't always have to be on their field of choice, we know that bodies aren't always as

able as we want them to be. It's why we want to stress the continuation of sharing knowledge and fostering growth within the community.

What made you select His Excellency Gideon Hravensfuri as the premier recipient?

G: As we were discussing who should receive the first Shield of Saint Ursul award, there was one person who was at the front of my mind. He has been a mainstay of the barony throughout my time in the SCA. I can't think of a baronial armored fighter who has not been influenced by Gideon to some extent through his years fighting at Tournaments, Wars, and practices. That doesn't even take into account the time he's spent working with newer fighters, helping people develop their skills and gear to get authorized.

Z: Gideon was the first person to come to my mind when we were discussing the premier. Even though he doesn't make it into the eric or on to the war field as often as he once did, there isn't a rattan fighter in Aquaterra who doesn't know him. He's impacted every generation for as long as he's been playing here. Gideon shares his story and by doing so we learn. He has created his own legacy within the martial community and somehow manages to keep his legend going every year through his usual Ursulmas Gideon de Noirville Over 40 Tournament. He is the example.

Updates from Kingdom/Society Officers:

In early January, the Society released a new edition of The Marshal's Handbook, which made several changes to the rules for armored combat. An Tir will implement these beginning with Summits Spring Coronet the weekend of March 25-27. There are three major changes in the Society's rules that will affect An Tir; please see the March Crier and the revised SCA Marshal's Handbook for detailed information.

- 1: Rawhide will no longer be allowed as a covering on swords.
- 2: Non-Newtonian Fluid garments, such as those manufactured under the Zoombang brand, will now only be allowed as padding.
- 3: Fighters using a side strapped shield must wear padding on their elbows, even if that is more than 4 inches from the edge of the shield. If it's less than 4 inches away, then rigid protection is required.


